Dear Friends in Christ.

Each year around the beginning of October, Christians around the world pause to remember Saint Francis of Assisi, a man who lived more than 800 years ago, yet still inspires us today. Francis was known for his deep humility, his care for the poor, and his joyful embrace of all God's creation. He believed that every living thing — birds, beasts, and human beings alike — are our brothers and sisters under the loving care of our Creator.

One of the traditions that has grown from Francis's witness is the **Blessing of the Animals**. It is a time when we bring our beloved pets — dogs, cats, birds, horses, and more — before God in gratitude for the companionship and joy they bring us. For Francis, animals were not just possessions, but fellow creatures that reflect God's creativity and goodness.

When we gather for this blessing, we are reminded of something larger than ourselves: that God's covenant of love extends

is a way of proclaiming that God delights in life — all life.


